Applying for Admission

Luther College invites men and women with promise for success in college to apply for admission. Completed admissions files are reviewed by the admissions committee beginning in September. Applicants will be notified of admission decisions on a rolling basis. A completed application file consists of the following:

- The Luther College Application for Admission** (the Common Application, along with Luther's Common Application Supplement, is also acceptable). If you prefer, you may complete the Luther College Application for Admission online at <http://admissions.luther.edu/apply/>.
- Official high school transcript.** Please arrange to have a copy sent to the Admissions Office.
- ACT or SAT test scores.** Please have your scores sent to Luther if they are not included on your high school transcript. Luther's test codes are: **ACT-1330; SAT-6375**.
- An Educator Reference.** A reference form is found on the last page of this application packet. A letter from a teacher or guidance counselor is also acceptable. Please have the reference mailed to the Luther College Admissions Office.
- Official academic transcripts from all colleges attended** (for transfer students).
- Transfer Student Application Supplement** (for transfer students).

Applying for Financial Aid

You will automatically be considered for non-need based forms of assistance (for example, academic scholarships, Legacy awards, etc.) as a result of completing and submitting your Application for Admission. All students who plan to participate in a music ensemble, irrespective of major, may audition for a music scholarship. Auditions can be arranged through the Admissions Office. Please have your audition completed by March 1.

We encourage all families to apply for need-based financial aid. To apply, you should complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and mail it to the federal processor by March 1. Be sure to list the Luther College code, **001874**, in the school release section of the application. The FAFSA can also be completed online by visiting www.fafsa.ed.gov.
