- Scholarships are awarded without regard to religious affiliation.

Please submit an essay addressing either Part A or Part B. The essay should be typed and two or three pages in length.

PART A

Describe how you have demonstrated your commitment to peace and justice through at least one of the following:

1. Completed a specific peace and justice project.
2. Were courageous in carrying out your convictions about peace and justice.
3. Displayed ongoing commitment to, and leadership in, a peace organization.
4. Served as a role model for others in moving church or society into new realms of thought and practice regarding peace and justice.

Also address:

5. How this scholarship will be used, and
6. How this award would affect your future work for peace and justice.

PART B

Demonstrate how the use of the award money for special study, an internship, or a special project will deepen your personal commitment to peace and justice and will promote peace and justice for others.
