

**SIX-YEAR GRADUATION RATES FOR LUTHER STUDENTS WHO ENTERED IN THE FALL OF 2005
AND WERE EITHER RECIPIENTS OF A PELL GRANT OR A SUBSIDIZED STAFFORD LOAN**

The tables below show the six-year graduation rates of students who entered Luther College in the fall of 2005 (i.e., the Class of 2009), and were recipients of federal Pell grants (Table 1) and recipients of federal subsidized Stafford loans (Table 2).
