Notes: Graduation rates are calculated according to the number of students in an entering fall cohort who graduate within six years of entering. Students who transfer into the institution are not included in these counts. This table categorizes students using the federal government's race/ethnicity categories. "International students" in this table are non-U.S. citizens; all others listed by race/ethnicity are either U.S. citizens, or permanent residents. "Unknown students" are those who declined to self-identify themselves on college documents. Because of the small numbers of students in some of the race/ethnicity categories, three years' worth of data have been combined in order to smooth out some of the year-to-year variations and present a more accurate picture.
